
Sickness and Health.


Officer Reports: VP& Repeater trustee

Repeaters are working. Upcoming changes with DOT/SARnet eliminating problems connecting with repeater 444.925. Hardware is set up. Antenna physical spacing needs work. The signal antenna conflict still exists due to being relocated too close to each other in 2016. (UF rearranged multiple antennas for multiple vendors.) Only work on tower is being completed by vendors. We have the required materials, just need an opportunity to fix it. Pete, Shannon, Rob Carr met together. (Rob is retiring June 24.) Might consult a tower crew, but will need permission. (New Journalism dean arriving around Oct. Need to build new relationships.) Possible solution: could shut down 985 to cut signal interference.

JUNE FIELD DAY 2020

- ► 1x1 special event call
- Social distancing protocols. Masks. Limit # of people within a building/etc.
- Scheduled a site inspection on 6/5 after old goats breakfast. Shannon has a key to the old library. Will measure for antenna and power layout. Goal is to insert power through windows. 2 possible hoist stations. Possible cot location. Have tables. Have pavilion with a roof. Redesign and scale all equipment and stations.
- Need more people on the GARS field day crew.
- Have met with Kim Worley, city manager, and facilities manager, Mr. Guillermo.
- Remote station, using 480s need to practice connecting transceivers, laptops, to local Wi-Fi.
- Logging: Larry's solution windows server (world wide, with IP address) Can log remotely via Internet. Now need to be able to work remotely through a router. Need strong Internet connection. Will attempt to connect remotely with other computers. Step one: Install logging program on local computer. Step two: set up network with IP address. TCP adjustments. (Larry@rovak.net)
